Location: Danville Family YMCA, 1111 N. Vermilion St., Danville, IL 61832 (Parking for the

facility is to the rear of the YMCA and not accessible from Vermilion St.)

Facility: Competition pool is 6-lane, 25-yard pool with a starting depth of 11' and turn

depth of 3'3". Anti-wave lane lines, Daktronics timing system, with a six-lane

scoreboard.

Spectator seating is in the balcony area overlooking the pool as well as the concession area above the south area of the pool. There is no on deck seating for spectators and limited seating for swimmers. Team seating will be assigned in the gymnasium, if enough space is needed. The gymnasium and locker rooms/pool are on different levels of the facility.

Lockers are available in the locker rooms. Swimmers should bring their own locks to secure their belongings.

A concessions area will be available throughout the meet in the Community Room overlooking the pool.

Rules/Safety: This meet will be conducted in accordance with USS technical rules, National

YMCA rules governing swimming competitions, Illinois Area YMCA Competitive

Swimming Rules, and Illini District YMCA Rules.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted

in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in the locker rooms or other

designated areas is prohibited.

If masks are required by the State of Illinois/CDC, masks should be worn in the

building.

Eligibility: Open to all swimmers who are YMCA members. Swimmers age as June 29, 2024,

will determine the age group for the meet.

Entries: Swimmers may enter a maximum of four (4) individual events and two (2) relay

events.

The meet will <u>NOT</u> follow a traditional YMCA formatted meet. Please make sure to take that into account when determining events. All events are open to all

ages except the 25s, which are only open to 8 & Unders.

Officials: Officials are needed to help run the meet. Each team will be asked to provide at

least one official. If more can be provided, officials can be rotated throughout

the meet.

Timers: Timers will be requested from each team proportional to the number of

swimmers entered in the meet. Swimmers will need to provide a timer and

counter for the 1000 & 1650 events, which will be run as one event.

Awards: Ribbons will be given to the top six finishers in each age group for 12 & Unders

only.

Heat Sheets: Heat Sheets will be for sale at the concessions area for \$1.00.

Admission: There will be no admission fee.

Results: Results will be sent to each team at the conclusion of the meet.
